

Question 1—The first three items are located at ARHS. The HVAC improvements are recommendations from the Van Zelm report and neglect to address could result in catastrophic failure of the high school HVAC system. The chillers and paving are part of on-going repairs to the school. Acoustic improvements are for both middle schools in their cafeterias and auditoriums where noise levels make it difficult to be heard.

Question 2—The current outdoor athletic facilities, particularly in the stadium, are over 30 years old and have reached their end of life expectancy. Field 3 is used extensively for games and has never been updated to accommodate spectators. After 30 years, it is critical to address these facilities and bring them from 1990's standards to 2020's standards.

ALL WEATHER FIELD

- ⇒ Increase use of stadium from 1 sport to 6 sports
- ⇒ Increase number of athletes using stadium from 75 to 400
- ⇒ Create a teaching space for Health/PE classes during school day
- ⇒ Amity is the only DRG A & B school without an all-weather field
- ⇒ Allows for play and practice on same surface used for tournaments
