Drug-Free Workplace

The Amity Regional School District No. 5 (ARSD) Board of Education (Board), working with the Superintendent, will provide a drug-free workplace in accordance with the Drug-Free Workplace Act of 1988, the Drug-Free School and Communities Act of 1994, and its implementing regulations. The Board certifies that it will:

- 1. Notify all employees in writing that the unlawful manufacture, distribution, dispensing, possession or use of a controlled substance is prohibited in the ARSD workplace and specify the actions that will be taken against employees for violation of such prohibitions.
- 2. Make it a requirement that each employee whose employment is funded by a federal grant be given a copy of the statement concerning a drug-free workplace.
- 3. Notify the employee in the required statement that as a condition of employment under the grant, the employee will abide by the terms of the statement, and will notify ARSD of any criminal drug statute conviction for a violation occurring in the workplace no later than five days after such conviction.
- 4. Notify the federal agency within ten days after receiving notice from an employee or otherwise receiving notice of such conviction.
- 5. Take one of the following actions within 30 days of receiving notice with respect to any employee who is so convicted: take appropriate personnel action against such an employee up to and including termination or require such employee to participate satisfactorily in a drug rehabilitation program approved for such purposes by a federal, state, or local health law enforcement or other appropriate agency.
- 6. Make a good faith effort to continue to maintain a drug-free workplace through implementation of all the provisions of this policy.
