## **Senior Service Learning Program Expectations**

The Senior Service Learning Program (SSLP) is a three-week, credit earning work experience. Students are expected to gain exposure to a job site while working alongside a mentor. In addition, students will make a presentation to the Amity community, as well as submit a signed timesheet to reflect that they completed the required hours. The 2020 Senior Service Learning Program will run from Monday, May 18<sup>th</sup> through Friday, June 5<sup>th</sup> (13 days). The student needs to accumulate at least 78 hours to successfully complete the SSLP.

### **Work Site Mentors are expected to:**

- Provide structured, meaningful tasks for the student
- Sign the provided agreement with the student and a parent or guardian
- Support your student and answer questions as needed
- Conference with your Amity HS contact person at least once during the program (via phone, email or appointment)
- Complete the site evaluation form
- Sign off on the student's timesheet
