# **College and Career of the Week**

The <u>University of New Haven</u> (UNH) is a private university located in West Haven, Connecticut. UNH enrolls approximately 5,000 undergraduate students and offers over 100 <u>majors & programs</u> in fields such as business, engineering, criminal justice and communication. UNH is also test-optional - no SAT/ACT scores are necessary for admission. There are an abundance of extracurricular opportunities on campus, including many <u>clubs and activities</u>. The "Chargers" sponsor 19 <u>athletic teams</u> (including E-sports) that compete in the <u>Northeast-10 Conference</u> (NCAA D-2). <u>Annual tuition, room and board</u> is \$64,932 (2023-2024). "<u>Dental hygienists</u> examine patients for signs of oral diseases, such as gingivitis, and provide preventive care, including oral hygiene (Bureau of Labor Statistics, 2021). <u>Dental hygienists</u> work in dental offices and may work either full or part time hours. An associates degree is needed to work in this profession and <u>state licensure is required</u>. The median salary is \$77,810 and *faster than average job growth is expected at 9%* through 2031 (BLS, 2021).
