- Class of 2024 Senior Portraits: Senior portrait sessions for the Class of 2024 will be held by appointment at Robert Taylor's studio in Stratford throughout the summer. Details are available here.
- Class of 2023 Yearbook Distribution: Yearbook distribution for the Class of 2023 will occur on campus at ARHS in late June. Specific details will be announced via the yearbook website (amityembers.com) and social media accounts as soon as they are available. Because all school e-mail addresses for the Class of 2023 will be disabled after graduation, new graduates are advised to follow @AmityEmbers on Facebook and/or Instagram for these announcements. Members of the Class of 2023 are also advised that they will need to present and scan a form of school ID (either their school-issued ID card or the Swipe K12 app on their phones) to pick up their books. Current underclass students will receive their books when school resumes in the fall.
- Class of 2023 Yearbook Signing Opportunity: During the senior breakfast on June 8, the yearbook staff will be revealing the cover of *Embers* 2023 as well as announcing the recipient of this year's yearbook dedication. All attendees will also be receiving signature supplements, which are sixteen-page inserts of blank pages that students can share and sign. They are made of the same type of paper used in the yearbooks, are the same height and width as yearbook pages, and feature an adhesive strip so that they can seamlessly become part of students' books once they arrive. All seniors are encouraged to come to the senior breakfast prepared with pens for signing one another's supplements. No pens will be provided at the event.

## **College and Career of the Week**

Gateway Community College was founded in 1992 when the former South Central Community College and the Greater New Haven State Technical College merged. Gateway's main campus is now located in downtown New Haven with a satellite campus in North Haven (home of their automotive program). Gateway is one of 12 community colleges in Connecticut that have recently been renamed CT State. With one application, CT State students can attend their local community college yet access over 300 programs of study through both in-person and online courses. Campus services such as financial aid, wellness centers and career services will remain available on local campuses. Annual tuition for full time, in-state residents is \$ 4,736.00 (2023-2024). "Railroad workers ensure that passenger and freight trains operate safely. They may drive trains, coordinate the activities of the trains, or control signals and switches in the rail yard" (Bureau of Labor Statistics, 2021). While a high school education is required for most railroad workers, all positions will have extensive on the job training. The national median salary is \$64,150 and slower than average job growth (5%) is expected through 2030 (BLS, 2021).
