Amity Happenings and Information

- Haven's Harvest Food Rescue Starting Next Week: Amity Regional High School is again partnering with Haven's Harvest, a New Haven-area food rescue organization that supports families and area food pantries in the greater New Haven area. We will begin collecting unopened and unused packaged food items and produce at all breakfast and lunch waves. Students can simply drop off what they do not use in the conveniently located donation boxes in the cafeteria.
- Reminders from the Health Office: Current DPH guidelines allow students who are experiencing potential Covid-like symptoms to attend school if they test negative for Covid each day they have symptoms. Free test kits are available in the Health Office for students who need them. Students with Covid-like symptoms who test positive or who do not test daily are required to quarantine, and parents should report positive Covid results to the Health Office so that we can accurately manage the health needs of our school community.

- Order and Prepay for Underclass Pictures: Ahead of our upcoming underclass picture days on September 20 and 21, parents can order and prepay for prints of their children's school pictures online beginning on Tuesday, September 6. Instructions are available here. The payment portal will be active until Wednesday, September 28. After this date, Amity's bulk order will be processed, and digital proof cards will be e-mailed to parents who did not place orders. These proof cards will feature a watermarked proof image along with the codes to order prints online. At that point, prices will be slightly higher, and orders will be shipped directly to families' homes rather than to the school.

The Department of Nursing boasts a 98% pass rate on the NCLEX exam (a national nursing exam). SCSU can be a great financial aid safety school on anyone's college list as full-time, in-state students pay \$12,438 for annual tuition (2022-2023). Their "Financial Literacy & Advising" service helps students and their families make good financial decisions regarding college costs. "Registered nurses (RNs) provide and coordinate patient care and educate patients and the public about various health conditions" (Bureau of Labor Statistics, 2021). In order to become employed, Registered nurses must graduate from an accredited nursing program at a college, university or nursing school and pass a national certification exam called the NCLEX. Nurses must also obtain state licensure in each individual state. Many nurses choose to specialize in a specific area of practice such as pediatrics (with children) or oncology (cancer patients). The median salary for nurses is \$77,600 (national average) per year and the profession is expected to have average growth at 6% through 2031 (BLS, 2021).
