College Board is strict about deadlines for registration, so please sign up on time! Registration is open from Friday, September 30, 2022 Friday, November 4, 2022.
  - AP Exam Fee: \$102 per exam
  - AP Seminar and Research Exam Fees: \$150 per exam
  - Late Fee: Registration will reopen from November 18, 2022 March 8, 2023 but will have a \$40 extra late fee (as set by College Board, not ARHS)

- Cancelation Fee: If you cancel by March 8, 2023, \$40 of your registration fee will go to College Board and the remaining will be refunded

Students in grades 10 and 11 will be taking the PSAT during the school day. No registration will be required. All students in grade 12 will not be required to attend school and should use the day to make a college visit or work on college applications or other post-secondary plans.

## College and Career of the Week

The <u>University of Rhode Island</u> is a public university, originally established around 1890. The <u>main campus</u> (one of five) is located in Kingston, Rhode Island, approximately 90 miles from the BOWA area and 8 miles from Narragansett Beach. A major research university, URI enrolls over 14,400 undergraduate students - 52% from Rhode Island. Students are offered over 100 <u>academic programs</u> and has a 17 to 1 student-faculty ratio. Campus life is active with over 130 <u>clubs and organizations</u> to choose from. URI is an NCAA-D1 university with 17 <u>sports teams</u> that compete in the

<u>Atlantic 10 Conference</u>. <u>Annual tuition, room & board</u> is about \$48,000 (2022-2023) for out-of-state students. For more information, please visit URI's <u>admissions website</u>, check out their <u>quick facts</u>, or take a <u>virtual tour here</u>.

"<u>Pharmacologists</u> study the effects of drugs and other chemicals on animals, humans and plants" (Universities and Colleges Admissions Service, ucas.com, 2020). They are different from pharmacists, who prepare and dispense medicines/drugs. Simply put, pharmacists use the knowledge gained by pharmacologists, who create medicines/drugs. "<u>Pharmacology</u> is the science of how drugs act on biological systems and how the body responds to the drug" (aspet.com, 2022). The current<u>median</u> <u>salary</u> for pharmacologists is \$82,434 (payscale.com, 2022). According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, <u>medical scientists</u> can expect to see *MUCH faster than average job growth at* 17% through 2031 (BLS,2021).
