WHAT IS SSLP?

The <u>Senior Service Learning Program</u> (SSLP)

(aka - the internship program) -

is a program where seniors work a 78 hour long, career-focused internship at a job site OUTSIDE of Amity High School. SSLP will take place from May 18th through June 5th. Seniors report to work sites daily and must participate in the Presentation Forum in June.

WHAT DO YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT SSLP?

Seniors will:

- •attend work at their designated site for approximately 6 hours each work day. They do NOT attend school.
- •participate in their athletic, club and any other school activities after the school day, as usual.
- provide their own transportation to and from job sites.
- •make prior arrangements with job site mentors for time off for school activities such as Senior Picnic, sporting events, etc.

WHAT IS SIP?

The <u>Senior Interest Project (SIP)</u> - is a comprehensive project that is to be developed, designed and executed solely by the student(s). Project ideas must be pre-approved and seniors must present their projects at the Presentation Forum in June. SIP will take place from May 18th through June 5th and students will continue to report to school everyday.

WHAT DO YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT SIP?

- Project ideas must be pre-approved
- Seniors must have a faculty mentor to work with
- Project is designed to give students an opportunity to explore areas of their own intereston their own terms
- Participating seniors WILL ATTEND school everyday but will not attend their regular classes. They will meet in the library.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- 1. <u>Minimum 2.0 cumulative unweighted GPA</u> (as of end of JANUARY, 2020)
- Seniors must be in good standing with the school - Administration, counselors, & faculty will review applicant list.
 - Attendance: *If you lost or lose credit in any class during your senior year, you are unable to participate.*
 - Discipline
 - Unpaid Fees

3. Credit for all fourth quarter courses will be contingent on successful completion of SSLP or SIP

SSLP SITE PLACEMENTS

- 1. A list of previous job sites are available for review in the Career Center. Please make an appointment with Mrs. Cocco to review/discuss.
- 2. Students may be required to interview or fulfill other business specific requirements as part of each sites' individual placement process.
- 3. Businesses owned by relatives may NOT be used as a site placement for a related student. Administration has final discretion on site placements.

- 4. All job sites must be pre-approved (via Preliminary Contracts).
- 5. <u>Students are not permitted to receive</u> <u>monetary compensation for their work.</u>
- 6. Yale-New Haven Hospital is no longer a possible job site (due to their policy changes)
- 7. Site placements must comply with CT state safety regulations.

Decision responses will be made by March 13th

FINAL SSLP CONTRACTS ARE DUE by Thursday, March 26th

WORK SAFETY LESSON


