Morehouse College (MC) is a private, liberal arts college for young men located in Atlanta, Georgia. Founded in 1867, MC is an HBCU (historically black college or university) that ranks #4 out of all HBCUs (US News & World Report). Also, MC is part of the "Atlanta University Center", a consortium with Spelman College and Clark Atlanta University. The college's mission is to "develop men with disciplined minds who will lead lives of leadership and service". MC offers its 2,200 undergraduates over 30 majors and minors to choose from. Social opportunities here are plentiful with a generous array of clubs, organizations and athletics (NCAA D2, Southern Intercollegiate Athletic Conference). Annual tuition, room and board is approximately \$45,000 (2022-2023). To learn more, check out MC's admissions website or read about their facts and figures.

"<u>Barbers, hair stylists, and cosmetologists</u> provide haircutting, hairstyling, and other services related to personal appearance" (Bureau of Labor Statistics, 2021). All <u>barbers, hair stylists and cosmetologists</u> are <u>licensed</u> by their state of residence and usually work full time. Training can be accomplished through trade schools or apprenticeships. The national average annual salary is \$29,680 with *faster than average job growth expected (11%)* through 2031 (BLS, 2021). However, the average annual salary in <u>CT is</u> <u>higher</u> at \$35,180, and more job openings are expected to become available due to retirements and general attrition.
