Link Crew 9th Grade Parent Orientation Night: *Want to know more about Link Crew?* On the evening of Wednesday, August 25th, from 7:00 pm to 8:00 pm, all incoming ninth-grade parents or guardians are invited to attend an interactive informational Link Crew assembly in the Amity High School main gymnasium. The Link Crew coordinators will be talking about Link Crew and shedding some light on Friday's Ninth Grade Orientation. Please note: this session is open to parents/guardians; students should not attend.

Link Crew 9th Grade Orientation: Amity Link Crew's Ninth Grade Orientation will be held in person on Friday, August 27th from 8:00am-1:15pm. Parents and guardians are asked to enter the back entrance via N. Pease Road and follow a one-way traffic flow down the driveway toward the high school to drop their children off by 8:00 am (when the event begins). Upon arrival, they will be greeted by Link Leaders. Masks must be worn by all students while indoors. A cookout lunch at the pond will be provided for free before the 1:15 pm pick-up. Please follow the same traffic pattern entering from N. Pease for pick up at the pond. Please note: there are no bus runs on this day. Parents or guardians are asked to provide transportation.

Save the Date-Senior Parent Night: Senior Parent Night will be held in person on **September 2nd at 6:30 at ARHS**. Counselors will provide an overview of the college application process for parents. As these meetings will take place in classrooms, we will need to limit attendance to **one parent or guardian per child**. An invitation and registration will be sent by your child's counselor by the end of next week. A copy of the presentation will be sent out after that night for those who cannot attend.
