# **Amity Happenings and Information**

- October 12th programming: Students in grade 9 will be taking the PSAT 8/9 during the school day. No registration will be needed. Students in grades 10 and 11 will be taking the PSAT during the school day. No registration will be required. All students in grade 12 will not be required to attend school and should use the day to make a college visit or work on college applications or other post-secondary plans.
- Amity Regional School District has partnered with Griffin Health to offer a COVID Vaccination Clinic on Thursday, September 22, 2022. The clinic is open to all staff, students, and accompanying adults in the Bethany, Orange, Woodbridge, and Amity school districts. The clinic will be located at Amity Regional High School for BOWA staff and students from 11:00 am - 4:00 pm, and it will then be open to the public from 4:00 – 5:00 pm. - Underclass Picture Days: Underclass pictures will be taken during English classes on Tuesday, September 20, and Wednesday, September 21. English teachers will inform their classes of which day to prepare for. Those students who are absent or otherwise unable to be

• Order and Prepay for Underclass Pictures: Ahead of our upcoming underclass picture days on September 20 and 21, parents can order and prepay for prints of their children's school pictures online. Instructions are available <u>here</u>. The payment portal will be active until Wednesday, September 28. After this date, Amity's bulk order will be processed, and digital proof cards will be e-mailed to parents who did not place orders. These proof cards will feature a watermarked proof image along with the codes to order prints online. At that point, prices will be slightly higher, and orders will be shipped directly to families' homes rather than to the school.

### **College and Career of the Week**

The <u>University of Southern Maine</u> is a public university with <u>3 campuses</u> located in Portland, Gorham, and Lewiston, Maine. Founded <u>in 1878</u>, USM currently enrolls about 6,000 undergraduate students and offers over 60 <u>undergraduate degree programs</u>. USM offers its students an active <u>residential life</u> with 75% of undergraduates living on campus. There are also many <u>clubs</u>, <u>organizations</u> and social opportunities to choose from. USM sponsors 22 NCAA-D3 <u>athletic teams</u> that compete in the <u>Little East</u> <u>Conference</u>. Annual tuition, room and board for out-of-state students is <u>approximately \$38,000.00</u> (2022-2023). • UCONN Application Process Updates: Since so many of our seniors apply to UConn, we are sharing some important information related to <u>changes in UConn's policies and deadlines</u>. The

application deadline for their highly selective special programs in Law, Medicine, and Dental Medicine has changed to November 15th. Nutmeg and Day of Pride Scholarship application process has also changed. Student may now apply to Day of Pride Scholarship or the Nutmeg Scholarship (not both) with a counselor's nomination. Interested students should submit their application for admission by October 25<sup>th</sup> and all supplemental materials by November 1<sup>st</sup>.

- All seniors will be meeting with their school counselors on Monday 9/19 or Tuesday 9/20 to learn about the process for applying to colleges. Students should check their school email for dates and times of the meeting schedule.
- **Financial Aid Night:** Financial Aid Night will be held on 9/29 at 6:30 PM in the Brady Center. Colleen Mulrooney, Director of Student Financial Assistance at Sacred Heart University will present an overview of the financial aid process for students who are applying to college.
