Yale University ITS High School Internship: The Yale Information Technology Systems Department has a Summer Internship Program that runs from July 9-August 3. This is a paid internship, and the experience is resumeworthy. Applications were e-mailed to all sophomores and juniors. Students will need to complete and hand in applications by Thursday, May 17th. An Amity High School committee will select the top three applicants to send through to Yale for the additional selection process. - 2. Must have a valid US Social Security Card
- 3. Students must demonstrate strong aptitude
- 4. Well rounded, enthusiastic learners
- 5. An interest in Information Technology
- 6. Must be at least 16 by July 1, 2018
