**College and Career of the Week:** This week's college is **Quinnipiac University**, and the career of the week is **Physical Therapy**. Quinnipiac is a "nationally ranked private university with 3 campuses, a college of arts and sciences and 8 professional schools, 10,000 students and 50,000 alumni who live and work in 61 countries". Programs include majors in business, engineering, medical/health sciences and arts & sciences. For more information, please visit their <u>website</u>. The profession of physical therapy is growing and according to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, is projected to grow 28% between 2016 to 2026. Physical therapists work in hospitals, private practices and other health care related service businesses to deliver programs of physical treatment that maintain, improve, or restore physical functioning, alleviate pain, or prevent physical dysfunction in patients.
