### I. Overview

- Amity switched to Self-Funding for 2012-2013
- Objectives:
  - 1. Improve Control Over Plan Costs
  - 2. Reduce Plan Costs Relative to Fully-Funded
  - 3. Capture Value of Favorable Claim Patterns
- Results:
  - 1. Self-Funded costs lower than Fully-Funded
  - 2. Actual Self-Funded costs in line with Expected Self-Funded Costs
  - 3. Annual Variability in Claim Costs Falls within Underwriting Parameters

# II. Financial Summary

Cost Reduction over 4 Years: \$2.1 million

Additional Cost for 2016-2017 to be

Fully-Funded: \$615,000

Cumulative Actual Vs. Expected Claim Levels over 4 Years:


